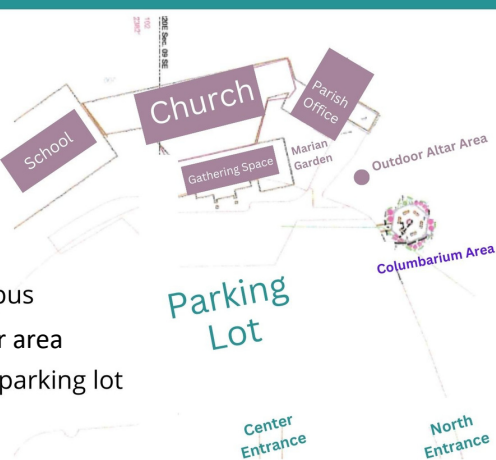
We are very pleased to be accepting applications to our newly constructed columbarium. We currently have four beautiful units available.

WHAT IS A COLUMBARIUM?

A columbarium is a permanent, sacred resting place for those who have died and been cremated. It has niches for funeral urns. Like cemetery plots, niches are sold and the money raised pays for the construction and upkeep.

Our columbarium will include 672 niches to be built in phases. Our first phase is now complete. We will be moving forward with phase two once phase one is about 75% reserved.

The columbarium provides an option to inurn loved ones in a sacred space, in an environment cared for by the community of parishioners for generations to come.

12X12X12 NICHE PRICING SUMMARY

FOR CREMAINS OF PARISHIONERS

- Niches in the top four rows are \$3,500 each or two for \$6,500.
- Niches in the bottom row are \$3,000 each or two for \$5,500.
- The purchase price will include the right to inurnment; faceplate engraving in a standard content, font and size; and perpetual care. A portion of the money will also go into our Endowment Fund and remain there in perpetuity.
- The landscaping will include a variety of bushes, flowering perennials and grasses surrounding the columbarium.

FOR CREMAINS OF NON-PARISHIONERS

- Niches purchased for non-parishioners will be an additional \$1,000 each.



WHY CHOOSE OUR COLUMBARIUM?

Our columbarium is located just east of our outdoor chapel area on the North end of our property.

Our columbarium will support and nurture the Corporal Work of Mercy: to bury the dead with reverence, respect, and dignity and the hope of the Resurrection that is expected by the Church.

St. Leonard is “home” for many people, not just those local to Muskego. Our location offers a connection to family, friends and the Church, and we offer year-round visitation. Our nearby outdoor chapel area and Marian Garden are beautiful, natural extensions to remember and pray for our beloved deceased.
