Old Business

- Open House was successful and very busy. Thank you to Fr. Dan and staff for their presence and answering questions of prospective families and to the marketing committee for providing refreshments. The most common response to how families became interested in St. Leonard was word of mouth and positive feedback from current families.

New Business

- Marketing- St. Leonard is working with Pointer Marketing to create a uniform look between the school, parish, and Christian formation. The committee is working on securing a tent with logo and website to use at community events. A targeted demographic mailer is being sent out to families who will be eligible for K3 in the future. They are seeking new committee members; the majority of marketing work can be done from home via computer.
- Enrollment- Materials will be coming out mid-March for the next school year. Enrollment is currently open for next year and we have about 5 students enrolled in K3 and K4. Charlie DuPont is working on updating a cost comparison informational sheet comparing St. Leonard's K3 and K4 to other facilities in the community. Enrollment in the School Choice Program is currently open and closes on April 20th.
- New Grading System- Next year the Archdiocese is moving to the Standards-Based Grading System. This system will be like systems currently used in most public schools in our area. The Diocese will be sending out an informational letter and there will be parent meetings to help explain the new grading process. Teachers had their first in-service this month and are working hard to understand the new system.
- Bus Issue- Safety concerns have risen about the release of a sex offender in the area and Lamers' policy about bus stops specifically in the vicinity of a sex offender. Muskego-Norway School District sets the busing contract for our school.

Action Steps

Mrs. Ellis will be contacting a member of the Muskego-Norway School District and a member of the school board to advocate for families regarding the bus safety issue.
