Thank you for agreeing to be one of our *Mask-a-teers*!

- We must use lightweight, 100 percent cotton (no canvas or duck cloth please)
- Elastic (any color) rope elastic, 1/8 inch or 1/4 inch only (only sizes we can use)

Please launder the fabric in **UNSCENTED Laundry SOAP** and do not use fabric softener. Press material before cutting.
