Processing Masks for Distribution

Per our insurance company, individuals who bag the masks for distribution must follow all instructions below—and—must abide by the following:

- Must have a smoke free home
- Home must be free of any person who is COVID-19 positive or has any respiratory illness (influenza A/B, etc.,) or other contagious illness
 - Please launder the completed masks in warm water AND
 <u>UNSCENTED</u> LAUNDRY SOAP / <u>NO</u> FABRIC SOFTENER, in a lingerie
 bag to protect any elastic or wire parts

From this point forward, any time you are handling masks, please don clean gloves and your own mask

- Hang masks to dry (do not dry in dryer)
- Once thoroughly dry, press with hot iron to reset any pleats (be careful to avoid ironing elastic)
- Fold mask in half and place each mask into its own zipper bag
 - * Push out extra air and seal bag tightly
- Stack bagged masks flat and put into large gallon size zip lock bag—seal bag tightly when full



Clean / pressed mask individually bagged and sealed
