School Counseling Update!

Middle school students started learning about the signs and symptoms of anxiety and depression. We discussed how important it is to take care of themselves and look out for their fellow classmates. I emphasized how important it is to reach out to a trusted adult or friend if they ever need to talk about something. We are going to continue to have these conversations and talk about various ways that they can help themselves to avoid having those negative feelings in the first place!

The elementary students just finished up a lesson on small, medium, and big problems. They learned that small problems should have small reactions, not big ones. We read stories, did activities, and practiced identifying different problems.
