Tomorrow is our Carnival and Crazy Hair Day

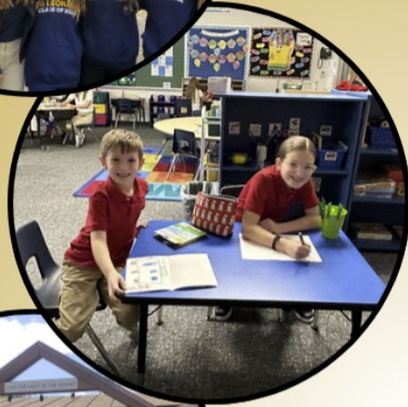

It is conveniently timed between two of our services with ashes. Please consider volunteering to bring a batch of soup or to help prepare, serve or clean up.

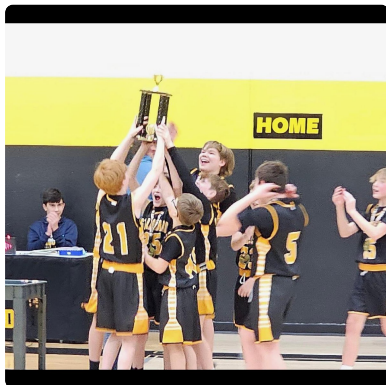
