Valentines Day, Fat Tuesday, and Ash Wednesday



This year, on February 14, 2024, there will not be a dispensation because Valentine's Day is on Ash Wednesday. So, classrooms will celebrate Valentine's Day on Tuesday, February 13th. Students may come that day dressed in red, pink, and white.

We will have our All-School Mass on Wednesday at 8am. All are welcome. Ashes will be distributed. Mass is planned by 3rd and 6th grade

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. During fasting, Catholics are allowed to have a main meal and two lesser meals which together do not equal the main meal. This applies to all persons between the ages of 18-60. Those over 60 years of age are not required to fast.

Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence from meat and meat products. We will not offer meat on Fridays for our hot lunch meal program and we encourage all families to practice abstinence from meat, too.
