NEW BUSINESS

- **Home Learning Experience Survey:** PSC reviewed the results of the home learning experience survey administered to parents two weeks ago. The committee discussed strategies to further balance the needs of school families, including streamlining SchoolSpeak, discussing learning outcomes and competencies, as well as a focus on increased interaction between students and teachers.
- **St. Leonard Spirit Week:** We are launching a spirit week complete with themed days next week, April 27th through May 1st.
- **Supply Pick Up:** On Friday, May 1st St. Leonard School will host two pick up times during which families can pick up supplies and materials that were left at school in anticipation of being able to return to school. Teachers are working this week and next to bag materials by student to make pickup as smooth as possible.
- **Material Drop Offs:** On June 2nd & 3rd, St. Leonard School will host days during which families can return school materials such as library books, Chromebooks, athletics supplies, etc. Families will likely be split alphabetically to pace the return of materials accordingly.
- **Virtual Learning Plan:** Faculty and staff continue to work on a long-term virtual learning plan so that it is available should virtual learning be required for any reason next year.
- **Enrollment Update:** Enrollment for the 2020-21 school year is looking strong. Nine students have pre-registered for K3. We currently have 10 students formally registered for K4 and 11 students for K5.
