



On the fly-leaf of the booklet Father O'Driscoll published to commemorate the opening of St. Mary's Church on Christmas Day of 1915, he wrote:

"St. Mary's parish was created by our present Bishop, Rt. Rev. James O'Reilly, D.D., on June 23, 1914. It comprises all Catholic families domiciled on the south side of DeMers Avenue and extends as far south as the half-way line between Grand Forks and Thompson. Rev. M. J. O'Driscoll was appointed to take pastoral care of the new parish by the Bishop. The first Mass was said in the Knights of Columbus Hall on September 15, 1914. A short time afterwards the congregation purchased one hundred by one hundred and forty feet of property on Belmont Avenue, opposite the Winship Triangle. On this property stands partly erected today what will be, when completed, one of the most artistic of small church edifices in the State of North Dakota. At the end of the book (listed below) appear the names of families and single persons who are members of the parish."
