“We let the contract for the school, totaling with all equipment, less than \$100,000 and the work started. Then, like a bolt out of the blue the depression of 1928 and the 30’s hit us amidst and we just about sank. We cried out like Peter, ‘Lord, save us or we perish.’ He must have heard, because we did not sink.

‘The depression had hit early in North Dakota. Mr. Murphy remarked to me in the years of the great national depression, called ‘the threadbare thirties,’ that the depression was just about over in North Dakota and the middle west when it began throughout the rest of the nation. That meant that many had already gone broke and had lost their farms or jobs before the great national depression of the early thirties. In fact Mike also told me the business of his office in one particular year did not make enough money to pay for the ink used.’
