The **HEAP Emergency Shut-Off Benefit** helps avoid any shut off of your heat and/or electricity by helping with bill payments.

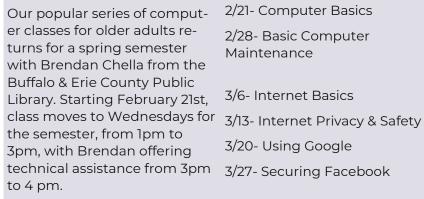
