Are you searching for the “right” church to belong to? Or do you want to learn more about the sacraments and the Church? Now is the time! Experience God’s love and care and broaden your knowledge for God and His Church by joining the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) group studies.

Are you a baptized Catholic desiring to complete your sacraments? Each year a number of people express their desire to become members of the Catholic Church. Others who are already baptized Catholics wish to deepen their faith by the completion of the sacraments of the Eucharist and Confirmation. Invite anyone from your household or family, neighborhood, work area, relative or friend who hasn’t finished the initiation process.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is a process by which a person discerns their choice of being a full member of the Catholic faith. The process allows for the Inquirer to gain the knowledge to make an informed, yet heartfelt decision to live as a disciple of Jesus Christ while embracing the Catholic faith.

The sessions are held on Sunday mornings at 9:30 AM until 11:30 AM. The group worships at the 11:30 AM Mass which is expected of all the members. The sessions are casual in nature as opposed to a classroom/course setting. There are presentations, small group discussion, prayer and coffee!
