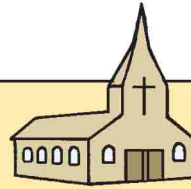

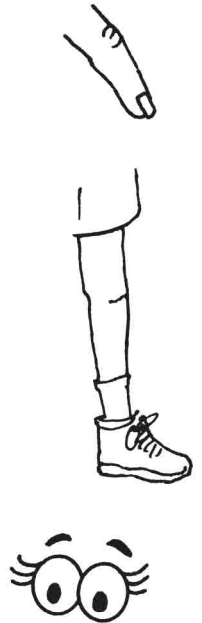
As the human body has many parts and all are important, so it is with members of the Church.
