*Confirmation Service Hours Record Sheet &
Reflection Instructions*

As part of the preparation for Confirmation, we engage in acts of service because we are a community of believers who have been Baptized into God's family. We are here to help one another, especially to be a voice for those who have no one to speak for them. Volunteering is part of a Christian life. We ask that as you complete your service project, totalling 8 hours of service by March 15, 2020. Some suggestions are: take part in fundraisers for various organizations (walk-a-thon, bike-a-thon), beach or park clean up days, organize a clothing drive or food drive to help those in need, tutor younger students at school, altar serve at Church, or help the Church in other ways, like assist at the Anointing of the Sick Mass, or with office work (available from time to time, and will inform you), making rosaries for missions with Catholic Daughters of the Americas (they meet at Mary's Nativity). As part of preparing for Confirmation, we write letters to the Bishop. The questions at the bottom of the table are a guide to help explain your service experience, and may help you to choose what you will do. These reflection questions can be referred to when you write your letter to the Bishop. The outline for the letter is part of the Confirmation packet.
