## CAFETERIA NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents,

Welcome to a new school year! I am stepping down as the cafeteria manager. Mrs. Katie Staples will be taking over. I will be staying on temporarily to help her transition into her new role. Please give her a warm welcome.

Our lunch times are as follows: Preschool-4<sup>th</sup> GRADE will eat at 11:30a.m. and 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade will eat at 12:15p.m. A complete lunch tray is \$2.95. This includes an entrée, one serving of fruit, one serving of vegetable, and a milk. Milk alone is \$.40. An entrée, such as a slice of pizza or hamburger, is \$1.75. A side, such as a salad or fruit, is \$.55. The Middle School students will be offered a la carte items. These are USDA Smart Snack compliant. Prices (ranging from \$.50-\$1 per item) will be listed on the lunch line. We will celebrate birthdays at the end of each month with a treat for ALL students.

The lunch menu will be emailed monthly. The lunch menu will also be posted on the school website and Jupiter Ed. Please print a copy and review with your child(ren). We will be doing OFFER vs. SERVE again. An explanation of OFFER vs. SERVE is located on the school website.

All lunch payments must go through the school office. Please pay by check and include your child(ren)'s name on the check. Because St. Michael participates in the National School Lunch Program, a delinquent lunch account policy is required. The lunch account policy can be found on the school website. Please read this policy.

Lunch account notices will be emailed weekly. If there is a negative sign in front of your balance, you owe money. If at any time you have questions regarding your child(ren)'s account balances, please contact me. It is important to keep these accounts paid.

If you have a child with a food allergy, it is very important that you talk with the cafeteria manager. We need to develop a plan for your child. We are not a

peanut-free facility. If you have a child who is unable to drink cow's milk related to a medical condition, a note from the medical doctor is required.

The St Michael Catholic School Wellness Policy was implemented last year as required by the National School Lunch Program. It is posted on the school website.
