#### What Is SCRIP?

SCRIP is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase SCRIP, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use SCRIP to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for St. Michael.

#### How SCRIP generates revenue for St. Michael's

The Great Lakes SCRIP Center acts on behalf of churches, schools and other non profit organizations to purchase large amounts of SCRIP from grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers. Because the SCRIP is purchased with cash up front, the participating retailers offer a substantial discount. St. Michael's buys the SCRIP from Great Lakes SCRIP Center at a discount, and re-sells the certificates to families like yours for full face value. The discount - from two to fifteen percent or more - is St. Michael's revenue.

#### SCRIP is "shopping cart fund raising"

SCRIP is a popular fundraiser because families don't have to sell anything. Organization members produce revenue by making regular household purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with SCRIP.

#### What are "On Hand" items?

**On-Hand** Items means that we have SCRIP in the listed denominations for the most popular vendors now.

#### WHERE and WHEN can I buy Scrip?

- Scrip will be available at **all weekend masses**.
- You can purchase Scrip **through school** by sending an order form (attach form) and payment to school with your child. Your child simply turns in the paperwork to his/her teacher by Tuesday, and your child will bring the scrip card home on Friday.
- Order on-line at WWW.SHOPWITHSCRIP.COM Cards will be sent home with your child on Friday or you can pay with PrestoPay and print or send select eGift cards within minutes.
