Baptism Requirement Packet

Baptisms are celebrated one Saturday a month.

English at 10:30 am – Spanish at 11:30 am

The Rite of Baptism for Children is only for children under the age of 7. Children 7 and older will need to receive "The Rite of Christian Initiation for Children" (RCIC); a process that takes at least 3 years.

Parent Requirements

- Complete the Baptism Registration Form.
- Attach a certified copy of child's Birth Certificate.
- Must attend Pre- Baptismal Class.

Godparent Requirements

Godparents accept the responsibility to raise the child in the Catholic Faith.

- Only one Godfather or Godmother is necessary; if two are chosen they MUST be the opposite sex.
- Must be 16 years or older
- Godparent/s MUST attend Pre-Baptismal Class
- A qualified Godparent MUST have all Sacraments of Initiation (*)
- * Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. If married Godparent MUST be married in the Catholic Church.
- ** Individuals only married civilly or living in a relationship without the Sacrament of Marriage DO NOT qualify as Godparents.
- *** Please Note that if you have chosen a person aside from a Godparent that do not meet all of the above qualifications, they can be considered a witness and MUST still attend the Pre- Baptismal Class.

Requirements must be completed two weeks prior to the date of the baptism ceremony.

A \$65 Minimum Stipend is required the day the Baptism Registration Form is submitted to the office.

Appropriate Dress Attire

Please be aware of this dress code is not adhered to on the day of the Baptism, the Priest or Deacon may ask to reschedule the ceremony until the dress code is followed.
