


EVERYONE DESERVES A LIFE

Prayer to St Michael the Archangel for the Conversion of Abortionists:

May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Grant us "the abundant life" promised to all who live according to Your Law. Amen.

The Sign of The Cross **With open hearts we pray.**

Glory and praise to You, Lord God, Our creator. We, Your daughters and sons, come here to this place in prayerful love, so that our unborn brothers and sisters will live outside their mothers womb. We believe that You are always present, particularly in the midst of sorrow and suffering. Prevent the screams of your innocent children my Lord.

We ask you to bless us, to lift up our hearts to You and to consecrate and accept this hour of reparation as a sincere regret and sorrow for this great evil which takes place within this building. We come together to bear public witness to Your great love and mercy which can move hearts and forgive sin. We ask for the intercession of the Holiest of Mothers, Your Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, under the title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Unborn, and of Your first protector, St. Joseph, that they will join their prayers with ours and bring an end to our nation's slaughter of our innocent unborn. Amen.

Preparatory Prayer

Eternal Father, Author of all life, I know that at this very moment a precious pre-born human life in the womb of his mother is in danger of a horrendous death. At this moment, Jesus, I am physically present at the scene to give a witness of your love for this tiny being you knit so wonderfully in his mother's womb. I wish to present my spiritual self here and, with heartfelt prayers and supplications, to send Heaven-bound all pleas and urgings that your Spirit rouse hearts to change and stop the killing of these your precious infants. Lord, I offer as a sacrifice all my labors, thoughts, prayers, inconveniences, sufferings and pains of this day to prevent a precious life from being denied the right to see the light of your day. I offer myself with all the sacrifices of the Holy Masses, which are ascending right now to your holy throne, and with all those who are speaking right now to Jesus in the Eucharist on behalf of the pre-born, in the hope that even one precious infant's life might be saved, that one might hold her child the day of his or her birth, that one father might carry his offspring even as your Son Jesus Christ was carried by his earthly father.

Precious infant in the womb, hear my longings and remember that God our Father said that even should a mother forget her infant, He will never forget you (Isaiah 49:15). I, too, united with my prayers and fastings this day with all your spiritual mothers and fathers who either right now are in your physical presence or who are in their homes, workplaces or wherever duty calls. I join also with unutterable urgings of the Holy Spirit that labors for your birth.

Remember, too, God's precious infant, that even as Rachel mourned her children who were no more (Jeremiah 31:15-17), we mourn and hope that the Mother of All Mothers, Mary our Mother, will turn these tears into a hope that no precious infant of God like yourself will have his or her life taken this day so violently.

Mary, Mother of God and Mother of us all, protect God's precious infants and intercede for them and for us, spiritual supporters, who pray and sacrifice daily for their lives, especially for those who at this very moment are in danger.

Finally, we pray that God forgives those mothers and fathers who this very day may make the tragic mistake and end the life of their children. But more so, God, we pray that this tragic mistake not be made.

I offer these prayers to you, my Holy Father, through the merits of Your Son, Jesus, who with You and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

The Glorious Mysteries

1st Glorious Mystery: The Resurrection

Christ is Risen! By his Resurrection, He has destroyed the power of death, and therefore the power of abortion. The outcome of the battle for Life has already been decided: Life is victorious! Let us pray that all pro-lifers will spread this victory to every segment of our society.

2nd Glorious Mystery: The Ascension

By ascending to the Father's throne, Christ takes our human nature, given to us in the womb, to the heights of heaven. He shows us that human beings are made to be raised to heaven, not thrown in the garbage. Let us pray that the world may learn this truth and reject abortion.

3rd Glorious Mystery: The Descent Of The Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is the Advocate: He pleads our cause, for we cannot save ourselves. We pray that He will make us advocates for the babies, who cannot speak or write or vote or protest or even pray.

4th Glorious Mystery: The Assumption

The Blessed Virgin Mary was taken body and soul into heaven because she is the Mother of God. Mother and child are united. The Assumption reminds us that they belong together. We pray that society will see that it cannot love women while killing their children and cannot save children without helping their mothers. We pray that people will be touched by the pro-life question, "Why can't we love them both?"

5th Glorious Mystery: The Coronation

Mary is the Queen of the Universe. The Church teaches that she is the greatest creature, second only to God Himself. The Church defends the dignity of women. We pray that people will understand that to be pro-life means to be pro-woman, and that to be pro-woman demands that we be pro-life.

The Sorrowful Mysteries

1st Sorrowful Mystery: The Agony In The Garden

Let us pray for mothers and fathers who are in agony because they are tempted to abort a child. May they be given the good news that there are alternatives, and may they make use of the help that is available.

2nd Sorrowful Mystery: The Scourging

As Christ's flesh was torn by the instruments of those who scourged Him, so the bodies of babies in the womb are torn by the instruments of the abortionists. Let us pray that abortionists may repent of these acts of child-killing.

3rd Sorrowful Mystery: The Crowning with Thorns

Jesus suffered the pain of thorns in His head and did so silently. We pray for the mothers and fathers of aborted children. So many of them suffer deep grief and regret over a choice they can never reverse. So many suffer in silence, because others tell them it's no big deal.

4th Sorrowful Mystery: The Carrying Of The Cross

Jesus was condemned by the power of wicked people. He was condemned because of the silence of good people. Silence always helps the oppressor, never the victim. Let us pray that we may never be silent about abortion, but rather will clearly speak up to save babies from death.

5th Sorrowful Mystery: The Crucifixion

As we ponder the death of Christ, let us remember the many women who have died from so-called "safe, legal" abortions. Let us ask forgiveness and mercy for them. May their memory save other women from making this tragic mistake.

The Rosary

The Joyful Mysteries

1st Joyful Mystery: The Annunciation

Mary is troubled by the angel's greeting, yet rejoices to do God's will. Let us pray that those who are troubled by their pregnancy may have the grace to trust in God's will.

2nd Joyful Mystery: The Visitation

John the Baptist leapt for joy in his mother's womb. We pray that people may realize that abortion is not about children who "might" come into the world, but is about children who are already in the world, living and growing in the womb, and are scheduled to be killed.

3rd Joyful Mystery: The Nativity

God Himself was born as a child. The greatness of a person does not depend on size, for the newborn King is very small. Let us pray for an end to prejudice against the tiny babies threatened by abortion.

4th Joyful Mystery: The Presentation

The Child is presented in the Temple because the Child belongs to God. Children are not the property of their parents, nor of the government. They - and we - belong to God Himself.

5th Joyful Mystery: The Finding in the Temple

The boy Jesus was filled with wisdom, because He is God. Let us pray that all people may see the wisdom of His teachings about the dignity of life, and may understand that this teaching is not an opinion, but the truth.

The Luminous Mysteries

1st Mystery of Light: Christ Is Baptized In The Jordan

When Jesus is baptized, the Father's voice is heard: "This is my beloved Son." All are called to become adopted sons and daughters of God through baptism. We pray that children in the womb may be protected, so that they may be born and welcomed into the Christian community by baptism.

2nd Mystery of Light: Christ Is Made Known At The Wedding Of Cana

Jesus revealed His glory by the miracle at Cana. The new couple was blessed not only with wine, but with faith in Christ. Let us pray for strong marriages, rooted in the Lord, and open to the gift of new life.

3rd Mystery of Light: Christ Proclaims The Kingdom And Calls All To Conversion

"Repent and believe the Good News." Let us pray that these first words of Jesus' public ministry may be heard by all who have committed abortion. May they know that the Lord calls them to conversion, and may they experience life-giving repentance.

4th Mystery of Light: The Transfiguration

Christ is transformed on the mountain, and the disciples see His glory. May the eyes of all people be transformed, that they may see each and every human life as a reflection of the glory of God Himself.

5th Mystery of Light: Jesus Gives Us The Eucharist

"This is My Body, given up for you." The Eucharist teaches us how to live and how to love. Let us pray that parents who sacrifice the babies for the sake of themselves may learn instead to put themselves aside for the sake of their babies.
