WHAT ABOUT THESE JESUS? Unborn, death-row, Euthanasia, Suicide, Human Trafficking

HOW DO WE TELL THEM? – WELL, WE NEED PURPOSE, FROM THE GOOD NEWS JESUS TELLS US THAT. Let's start with that.

Above all things, our God, so loved the world that He gave His only Son. We are wrapped and caressed in the love of our God, Holy Spirit and Jesus, so as to become a part of His life that He wants to share with us for all eternity. Through all the examples, signs, and gifts He has given us, time and time again, until He gave us His Son Jesus to be the new Adam and restart us, so that we could find the way through Jesus, that will save our soul, as we follow the way, truth and the life of Jesus and His Word from God. He has freed our soul from the bondage of this world and sin. So now it is free and will stay free if in the shelter of Gods bosom in the Kingdom that He has enabled on earth.

Our good news, our great news is I live my life with a purpose. Jesus died for us and destined me, you and all of us for eternal glory. God calls us to eternal glory and says sin is beneath

us. We are living in a world that lives outside God and it is only in living in the Kingdom here and now that we are spiritually free of its hold on us. All the laws, the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) and all the teachings from Jesus and the Holy Spirit are to guide us when we are confused or have lost our way, to recall this love, deep, deep love our Father God has for each and every one, and so designed a purpose for each of us, that only we can fulfill. We have a place with Him for eternity. Only we can fill that space with Him beyond time, beyond the realm of all we know, it is especially for you alone.

All these laws and commandments are all results and signs of the love relationship we feel, experience and live with Him. Our relationship and love, are more than just these laws and rules that are set before us; they are results of the intimacy of our love language between Abba [Father, Son Jesus, The Holy Spirit] and our heart, soul & mind. We must apply all things of this world with Jesus-with-us, by our side. call Jesus out loud, to proclaim Him as witness to all we do, whether it is reading, watching, looking, thinking, listening, doing and praying. When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together, and one of them tested him by asking, "Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?" He said to him, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments." (Mt 22:34-40)

Of Jesus' words above, we must use this love relationship with Jesus and know He is with us. The special feeling, we have or want to have, Jesus has with every single person God has created, just say yes.

God's true love is to provide us with what we need and allow us our free will, but not to provide our desires so as to lust after our attention or bribe us to His way, truth and life that He wants for us in our purpose.

We must succeed in this with His show of love of example that He has carved out in the path to eternal life. Follow Truth that He has given us, as it is shown to us over and over again, as it is fulfilled from the beginning to today and always being solid and unchanging. An example of a life that God has given through His Son Jesus, so there are actual actions of LOVE, compassion, patience, humility, perseverance, joy, peace, with someone of full Faith, Hope & Charity. Through all of the tribulations and adversities, Jesus stayed true to God's desire for His purpose. Mercy for all and complete love of all walks of life no matter how they treated Jesus, He always treated others as someone that had God in them.

And now we are to follow Him, make these ideas real in our own life, share the good news with all others so that they will see value in life and know there is purpose for them and everyone else, whether they are unborn, injured, deformed, mentally impaired, bad, good, old, defenseless.

Above all other things, show the things that are desired from all. (Of God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit) Show them love, gladness, hope for them, believe in them, give them what God wants them to know and see. The good news, what they could be, what God hopes for them, look beyond what you see, we don't see so good. Our eyes only see the world in the world's eyes. Keep faith and charity at the forefront, give them hope and give them the benefits, as Jesus would.

For the unborn,

(Never cease praying for our children given to us from God)

God loves every human and knows everyone before entering the mother's womb. [Jer. 1:5 / CCC 2270-2275]

we must be joyful to the nurses, helpers and doctors. Let them see what they have missed and let them see Jesus, the full package. Call His name and say Jesus please speak for me, so that your words reach him.

We must try to reach love for them and give them compassion and love humbly and patiently.

Sincerely with joy & love – Tell them "I think you are going to be an amazing mom, let me know if you need help!"

For the Death-row and imprisoned (Always pray before,

during and after your visits)

Find people of your community that are in prison, visit them, tell them the GOOD NEWS! Fetch a priest for them.

Assuming that the guilty party's identity and responsibility have been fully determined, the traditional teaching of the Church does not exclude recourse to the death penalty, if this is the only possible way of effectively defending human lives against the unjust aggressor. (CCC 2266 -2267)

All still are loved in the eyes of God. We must still seek their souls to find the Good News that even though they have sinned and how terrible it may seem to us, they still are desired by our God, because of the immense love He has for all that He has created. With guidance from a <u>Priest or Deacon</u> I suggest not to be scared, but bring Jesus Christ with you and add Him to all of the experience, so that you can witness Jesus to them and offer them hope and remove the evil in their heart if it is still there. (THE GOOD NEWS IS DESIRED FOR ALL, MAKE SURE IT IS OFFERED). Show them compassion and mercy, let them see what and how it should be and how wrong they may have been in their actions. Again, monitor all actions with the guidance of your priest, deacon, exorcist. Only use a psychiatrist through an exorcist recommendation! Very important!

For Euthanasia

(All along the Catholic Church under the tutelage of Pope John Paul II was not left behind in this issue. He issued a Declaration on Euthanasia in 1980 which opposed mercy killing but allowed individuals the right to refuse measures for sustaining life.)

When we stand quietly without witness and turn our backs on these abominations that are said to be for the quality of life or "death with dignity" and other reasons [or assist, giving a ride to their destination!]. This is not God's will, clearly stated in Bible verses:

'Then God said: Let us make human beings in our image, after our likeness.' – Genesis 1:26a

'You shall not kill' (one of the Ten Commandments) – Exodus 20:13

'In his hand is the soul of every living thing, and the life breath of all mortal flesh.' – Job 12:10

In the New Testament, the importance of human life is seen, for example, in these words...

'Look at the birds in the sky; they do not sow or reap, they gather nothing into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are not you more important than they? – Matthew 6:26

'Even all the hairs of your head are counted.' (by God) — Matthew 10:30 Jesus, the founder of Kingdom Living, cared for people who had a poor quality of life and for those who were regarded as outcasts in his society. Each person mattered to him.

Catechism of the Catholic Church

2276 Those whose lives are diminished or weakened deserve special respect. Sick or handicapped persons should be helped to lead lives as normal as possible.

2277 Whatever its motives and means, direct euthanasia consists in putting an end to the lives of handicapped, sick, or dying persons. It is morally unacceptable.

Thus, an act or omission which, of itself or by intention, causes death in order to eliminate suffering constitutes a murder gravely contrary to the dignity of the human person and to the respect due to the living God, his Creator. The error of judgment into which one can fall in good faith does not change the nature of this murderous act, which must always be forbidden and excluded.

2278 Discontinuing medical procedures that are burdensome, dangerous, extraordinary,

or disproportionate to the expected outcome can be legitimate; it is the refusal of "overzealous"

treatment.

Here one does not will to cause death; one's inability to impede it is merely accepted. The decisions should be made by the patient if he is competent and able or, if not, by those legally entitled to act for the patient, whose reasonable will and legitimate interests must always be respected.

For Suicide & the victims of Suicide

(Pray with the families and hold them and the deceased up in prayer, in their burden, listen to their story to help the grieved and through their loss with patience, humility, compassion)

These are incidents that happen in our community and families. Our understanding and knowledge of the incidents are usually vague and/or hear-say. We must console the families and attempt hope, reassure faith, never condemn the lost, but show possibilities of resolve with the Lord. Only God knows the truth and heart of all. We must show the best point of potential possibilities because it could be the truth just as the worst fear that they may be carrying, so help them in their reflection and relationship in their God and show them that face of God and Jesus they so much need to see.

2280 Everyone is responsible for his life before God who has given it to him. It is God who remains the sovereign Master of life. We are obliged to accept life gratefully and preserve it for his honor and the salvation of our souls.

We are stewards, not owners, of the life God has entrusted to us.

It is not ours to dispose of.

2281 Suicide contradicts the natural inclination of the human being to preserve and perpetuate his life. It is gravely contrary to the just love of self.

It likewise offends love of neighbor because it unjustly breaks the ties of solidarity with family, nation, and other human societies to which we continue to have obligations. Suicide is contrary to love for the living God. (CCC 2280-2283)

For the persons that are victims of Human Trafficking and for those that are the traffickers.

(Endless prayer is needed, it will be a wasteland of prayer for all because of the blindness of our vision and no knowledge of the actions one way or the other).

The physical victims are ones that receive capture, possession, obsession, and made a sex tool, or slave labor, or used for body parts and left to bleed out.

Such a disrespect for life & of the creation of God, it leaves us as humans with disgust and a terrible feeling of hating the terrible and cruel sins committed. We have to call ourself away from the gruesome gore and cruelty and look to God, and our Lord Jesus for prayer and alliance of faith and trust, that His love is enough and that those of these actions is divorced from or ignorant of God and needs to be given the same love we have been shown and reveal the great news of redemption and the eternal love and the assured possibility of redemption and salvation and start anew, even if the world sends him to his death at the gallows. This is a dangerous venture to get involved in and requires men and women of many years of training to save the afflicted and arrest the captors. We must continue prayer for these sufferers and the cross they bear with a slim chance of survival. The many sins they pay for the world through their gruesome suffering, may they find Jesus and may He hold each of their hands through their horrible ordeal.

Lastly, we should check with the Sheriff &/or police department to find ways to assist, donate, and pray for their success and safety to end this horrible evil.
