



## What to expect this year in Faith Formation K-5 2019-2020

Faith Formation Kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade meets on either Tuesday OR Wednesday afternoons from 4:30-5:45pm. Class time is approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes.

Your child will need to be signed in and out. Please wait to drop off your child until their teacher arrives.

K-1 grade classes will be using Promise bulletins and focusing on Gospel stories and prayers.

2<sup>nd</sup> grade classes use the Blessed program by Dynamic Catholic, studying the sacrament of First Reconciliation (Confession).

3<sup>rd</sup> grade classes use the Blessed program by Dynamic Catholic, studying the Sacrament of First Eucharist (Holy Communion).

**What to expect for Sacraments:** Requirements for parents of children preparing for Sacraments this year are as follows: **Baptized before 7 years old.**

1. NO more than 6 absences at their program, Sacramental retreats and Sacramental training during their regular program.
2. Reconciliation and Eucharist is part of grades 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classes.
3. Those in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade requiring Reconciliation can choose to take the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade class in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade class in 4<sup>th</sup> grade or attend for a year and get both Sacraments the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in Grooted.
4. All 4<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grade attend for 1 year then receive First Reconciliation and First Eucharist their 2<sup>nd</sup> year.

### **Unbaptized by 7 years old.**

1. Year 1-Attend class regularly (no more than 6 absences a year)
2. Year 2-Attend class each week (no more than 6 absences a year) and attend monthly family class.
3. Year 3-Attend class each week and 5 pm Mass weekly – receive all Sacraments at the Easter Vigil.
