PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD’S PASSION -- Our Lenten journey climaxes in this celebration of Holy Week. Throughout these days we are called to experience with Christ a journey of unselfish love; to die to all that is sinful in us and to rise to new and renewed life. Will justice and charity be renewed in us through this journey? Will we make room for those in need as we let selfishness die in us?

WHAT IS HOLY WEEK ALL ABOUT?

Holy Week is a time when Catholics gather to remember and participate in the Passion of Jesus Christ. The Passion was the final period of Christ’s life in Jerusalem. It spans from when He arrived in Jerusalem to when He was crucified.

Holy Week observances began in Jerusalem in the earliest days of the Church, when devout people traveled to Jerusalem at Passover to reenact the events of the week leading up to the Resurrection.

The Following Events Take Place During Holy Week:

- Palm Sunday [or Passion Sunday], the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem.
- Holy Thursday [Maundy Thursday], the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the betrayal by Judas.
- Good Friday, the arrest, trial, crucifixion, death, and burial of Jesus Christ.
- Holy Saturday, the Sabbath on which Jesus rested in the grave.

This concludes Holy Week. The following day is Easter Sunday, the day on which the empty tomb was discovered, and our Lord was resurrected, triumphing over death once and for all time!



WHO WILL JOIN OUR PARISH FAMILY THIS EASTER?

This year, we are blessed to have one “ELECT” who will join our parish family: **William D. Geidel Jr.** He will receive the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Please continue to pray for him, as he enters into the final week of preparation for the sacrament of initiation.

TRIDUUM [HOLY THURSDAY/ GOOD FRIDAY/ EASTER VIGIL] The Sacred Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday. It continues with the commemoration of the Lord’s passion and death on Good Friday, reaches its high point at the Solemn Easter Vigil, and ends on Easter Sunday. Then, the joyful Easter Season of the 50 days begins. Please come and join us during these three holiest days of the year. We look forward to celebrating these Holy Days with you and your family.

TRIDUO [Jueves Santo/ Viernes Santo/ Vigilia Pascua] El Triduo comienza en la Misa con la noche de la Cena del Señor en Jueves Santo. Friendly Reminder --

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of FAST. Catholics in good health ages of 18 and 59 are bound to fast. Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal. Catholic 14 and older are required to abstain from meat on Good Friday.
