THIS SUNDAY, APRIL 24TH, THE SECOND SUNDAY OF EAST-ER, IS ALSO DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY. THE TWO RAYS OF LIGHT FLOWING FROM THE HEART OF JESUS REPRESENT HIS DIVINE MERCY. ONE IS RED, REPRESENTING THE BLOOD HE SHED ON THE CROSS. THE OTHER IS WHITE, REPRESENTING THE WATERS OF BAPTISM. BOTH ARE SIGNS OF HIS MERCY TO US ESPECIALLY, WHEN HIS HEART WAS PIERCED WITH A LANCE WHILE HE HUNG ON THE CROSS, THERE FLOWED OUT BLOOD AND WATER. JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY -- The Image: Jesus appeared to St. Faustina in a vision, with his right hand raised in a blessing and his left touching his garment above his heart. Red and white rays emanate from his heart, symbolizing the blood and water that was poured out for our salvation and our sanctification. The Lord requested that "Jesus, I trust in You" be inscribed under his image. Jesus asked that his image be painted and venerated throughout the world: "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish" (Diary, no. 48) and "By means of this image I will grant many graces to souls" (Diary, no. 742)

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY -- In today's Gospel today Jesus greets his frightened and traumatized disciples with this greeting: Peace! The readings today convey that profound sense of peace that is the legacy of Jesus. This peace is not characterized by the absence of conflict, but rather, by a deep sense of well-being that accompanies a lively faith. Can we bring this deep sense of peace to those around us experiencing conflict? How can we be better peacemakers in our world by centering ourselves more fully in Christ?
