What is the Eucharist Revival? It is a movement of Catholics across the United States to be healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father’s call for a “pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are” so that the Church in the United States might be “permanently in a state of mission” (Evangelii Gaudium # 25).

“It certainly is our hope that all of us in the Diocese will develop a deeper and more profound understanding and appreciation of the gift and mystery of the Holy Eucharist through active participation in weekly and daily Mass, through private prayer, Adoration and devotion to the Real Presence of the Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in our churches, and through a personal transformation that leads us to bring Christ’s loving presence into our communities. As we begin the Eucharistic Revival in our Diocese this June, let’s recall the words of Pope St. John Paul II: ‘From the Eucharist comes strength to live the Christian Life and zeal to share that life with others!’” n--**Bishop Joe Vasquez**

Corpus Christi Mass and Procession Bishop Joe S. Vásquez calls the faithful of the Diocese of Austin to prayerfully begin a Eucharistic Revival with the theme “That they may all be one” (John 17:21). Join Bishop Vásquez on June 18, the Saturday before the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ [Corpus Christi], to kick off the Diocese of Austin Eucharistic Revival. The day begins with 8:30 a.m. Mass at San José Parish in Austin [2435 Oak Crest Ave] followed by a 1-mile procession at 9:40 a.m. to St. Edward's University's Main Building [3001 South Congress, Austin] where Bishop Vásquez will lead us in Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament [Adoration] at 10 a.m. For more information, visit austindiocese.org/eucharistic-revival.
