

## 30 DE OCTUBRE TRIGÉSIMO PRIMER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

**31<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time:** Today we hear the story of Zacchaeus, a man so interested in seeing Jesus, he gave up his dignity and climbed a tree. The people of his town saw Zacchaeus as a traitor and a cheat, but Jesus saw a man desperate for love and mercy. Zacchaeus saw in Jesus, someone who did not judge him and saw only his best and truest self. How do we see others? Do we see as God sees? Do we see the full dignity of every person as beloved of God and treat them with that dignity? What can we do this week to see people differently?

**Trigésimo Primer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario:** Hoy escuchamos la historia de Zaqueo, un hombre tan interesado en ver a Jesús que renuncia a su dignidad y se sube a un árbol. ### **PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY** [Last Sunday of October]--

Today is **PRIESTHOOD SUNDAY!** It seeks to reaffirm the priesthood of Jesus Christ and its central place in the life of the Church. This day also specifically honors priests, without whom the Holy Sacraments could not be conferred, for a single day out of the 365 days of the year during which they tirelessly serve their parishes. Celebrate and thank a priest today!

Whenever we interact with our priests, do we see them as human and frail like the rest of humanity? Or on the other hand, do we see them as supermen, able to withstand all the stresses and strains of being human? Try to see your priest as very human, quite possibly, even more human than most of us. Why? It’s because they not only have their own struggles being human, but they accompany us in our humanness too. Therefore, this Priesthood Sunday; turn the tables. Attempt to be the listener to the human side of your priest. Do not automatically tell him your troubles; begin by asking him what is going on in his life. Thank him warmly for giving up so much to spend his life in service to others. Try it. You might be surprised to find out your priest is just like you!
