The best prayer that Catholics have is the MASS... which is the greatest gift of all.

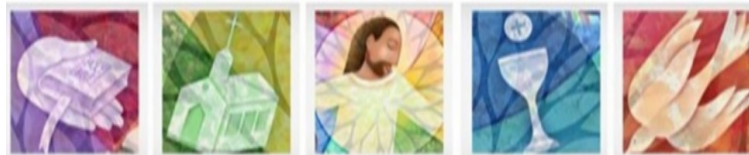
Why does Jesus give himself to us as food and drink? Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist as spiritual nourishment because he loves us. WORLD DAY OF MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES
