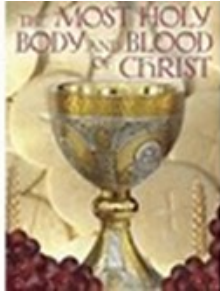

Amen  “Only the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, the food of life can satisfy the hunger of hearts for love, a universal experience.” [Pope Francis]	Temporary COVID--19 Protocols: Bishop Joe Vasquez has decreed dated May 29, 2020, parishes in the Diocese of Austin these revised temporary protocols when celebrating the sacraments, until further notice. - Attendance at liturgies may not exceed 50% of full seating capacity of churches or buildings in which they are celebrated - Encourage parishioners to maintain safe distance [6-feet] between each other - Inform parishioners who are sick; those who are 65 or older and those advised by health care workers to stay home and watch a live stream of Mass. The dispensation of the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation remains in effect. Protocolos Temporales de COVID--19 - El Obispo José Vásquez con el decreto del 29 de mayo, 2020 las parroquias en la Diócesis de Austin deben seguir estos protocolos temporales al celebrar los sacramentos, hasta nuevo aviso: - La asistencia a las liturgias no puede exceder el 50% de la capacidad total de asientos de las iglesias o edificios en lo que se celebran - Alentar a los parroquianos a mantener una distancia de 6 pies entre ellos - Informar a los siguientes que están enfermos; los mayores de 65 años y a quienes los trabajadores de salud les han aconsejado que asistan a Misa quedarse en casa para ver la Misa transmitida en vivo. La dispensación de la obligación de atender a Misa los domingos y días de precepto se mantendrán en efecto.
