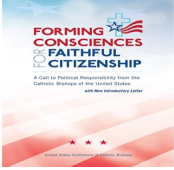

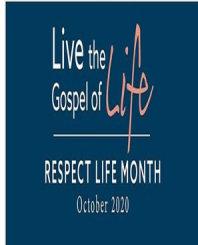
The Challenge of Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship

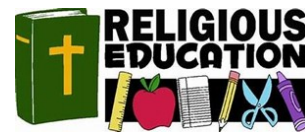
