Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Jesus sends us to proclaim the Gospel to the ends of the earth;

sometimes that might not even mean leaving our town or city. How is Jesus calling you to leave your comfort zone?

The best prayer that Catholics have is the MASS... which is the greatest gift of all.




The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
