The best prayer that Catholics have is the MASS... which is the greatest gift of all.





19 DE FEBRERO 2023- SÉPTIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

ASH WEDNESDAY – The act of putting on ASHES symbolizes fragility and mortality, and the need to be redeemed by the mercy of God. The Church uses ashes to symbolize that attitude of internal penance to which all the baptized are called during Lent. "REMEMBER YOU ARE DUST, AND TO DUST YOU SHALL RETURN" or "REPENT AND BELIEVE IN THE GOSPEL"



A Day of Fasting and Abstinence- While not a Holy Day of Obligation, Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence (not eating meat) and fasting [eating only one full meal and two small meals]. Fasting, especially as we begin our Lenten journey, is an opportunity to exercise detachment from the things of this passing world. Just as a mother insists her children put their phones down in order to be present to the family at the dinner table, the Church has made this day of fasting obligatory for anyone from 18 to 59 years old. The mentally, physically and chronically ill, as well as pregnant or nursing women are excused from fasting and abstinence.

What is Lent?-- Lent is the 40-day period leading up to Easter that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Thursday. Lent this year begins on Feb. 22, 2023. It is a penitential season celebrated primarily by the Catholic Church and some other Christian traditions. During Lent there is a strong focus on prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These spiritual exercises help prepare us for the celebration of the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus, more frequently known as the Paschal Mystery. ¿Qué es Cuaresma? -- La Cuaresma es el periodo de 40 días previo a la Pascua que comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza y termina el Jueves Santo. La Cuaresma este año comienza el 22 de febrero de 2023. Es una temporada penitencial celebrada principalmente por la Iglesia Católica y algunas otras tradiciones cristianas. Durante la Cuaresma hay un fuerte enfoque en la oración, el ayuno y la limosna. Estos ejercicios nos ayudan a prepararnos para la celebración de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús más conocida como el Misterio Pascual.
