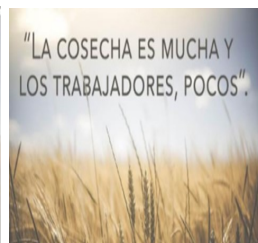
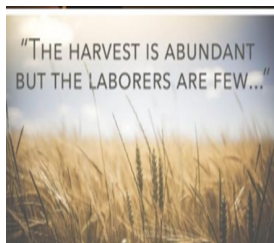

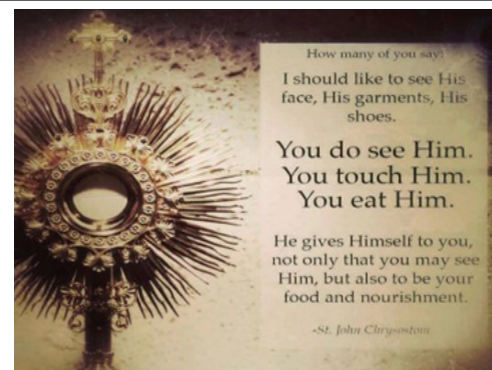
Many of us take our lives for granted. We think we have plenty of time to "repent."
