Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph is normally celebrated on the Sunday after Christmas. This year, the feast day is celebrated on Friday, December 30. This feast developed at the beginning of the 19th century in Canada and then spread to the entire Church in 1920. At first, it was celebrated on the Sunday after Epiphany. It is a Feast that seeks to portray the Holy Family of Nazareth as the "true model of life" from which our families can draw inspiration and know where to find help and comfort.
