
- Fast from judging others: Feast on the Christ dwelling in others.
- Fast from emphasis on differences: Feast on the unity of all life.
- Fast from discontent: Feast on gratitude.
- Fast from anger: Feast on patience.
- Fast from complaining: Feast on appreciation.
- Fast from bitterness: Feast on forgiveness.
- Fast from self-concern: Feast on compassion for others.
- Fast from idle gossip: Feast on the purposeful silence.
- Fast from personal anxiety: Feast on unceasing prayer.
