

WHAT IF I HAVEN'T BEEN TO CONFESSION FOR MANY YEARS?

- •First, don't be afraid. Jesus said, "Heaven rejoices more for one repentant sinner than for 99 righteous persons who never needed to repent."
- •Second, try to prepare with the help of a Good Examination of Conscience.
- •Third, get the largest sins off your shoulders first.
 Finally, don't wait!



FOUR STEPS TO RECONCILIATION

- •Step 1 Contrition Contrition is "sorrow of the soul and detestation for the sin committed, together with the resolution not to sin again."
- Step 2 Confession The confession [disclosure] of sins, even from a simply human point of view, frees us and facilitates our reconciliation with others
- Step 3 Absolution The priest speaks the words by which "God, the Father of mercies" reconciles a sinner to himself through the merits of the Cross
- Step 4 Satisfaction An important part of our healing is the "penance" the priest imposes in reparation for our sin.
