SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The sacrament of reconciliation is also known as the sacrament of conversion, confession, and penance: conversion because it is the first step in Jesus' call to conversion, confession because it is the acknowledgment and disclosure of sins to a priest, penance because it consecrates a sinner's steps of conversion. and reconciliation because it reconciles us to God and His love. Confession not only frees us from our sins but also conveys grace. This grace is what aids us in our spiritual journey to holiness. Sin damages our relationships and imperils our soul. Serious sin enslaves us preventing us from reaching our potential as disciples of Christ. Genuine sorrow for our sinfulness leads us to seek the grace that is needed to turn our lives around. The Sacrament of Confession or Reconciliation is our way of experiencing this grace through God's mercy and love. During Lent, let us remember Jesus is waiting for us in the confessional. He wants to breathe new life into our hearts that wither from sin. With his grace, we will never tire of hearing the words "...may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen."



NOTE: During these 40 days, we first of all repent. If we've not been to confession for a long time, or have serious sin on our souls, we prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We wake up and no longer take the risk of not being with God forever...in a word, Hell. We see how the seven deadly sins have wounded us. Remember 'pale gas'?
