

The Four Pillars of the Catholic Faith –

Today we are introducing the importance of the Catechism of the Catholic Church—a powerful tool that helps us grow in our understanding of the faith. This week, we take a closer look at the structure of the Catechism, which is built on four foundational pillars. These pillars guide us in how we believe, worship, live, and pray as Catholics.

1. **The Creed** – What We Believe: This first pillar explains the truths of our faith, professed each Sunday in the Creed. It reveals the mystery of God -- Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—and His saving plan for humanity.

1. **The Sacraments** – How We Worship: The seven sacraments are sacred signs instituted by Christ to give grace. Through them, we encounter God in tangible ways, from Baptism to the Eucharist and all the stages of life.

1. **The Commandments** – How We Live: Grounded in Scripture and Tradition, this pillar helps us form a moral life. It teaches us to love God and neighbor, and to live in freedom and truth.

1. **Prayer** – How We Encounter God: Prayer strengthens our relationship with the Lord. The Catechism highlights the Lord's Prayer as the model for all Christian prayer. These pillars shape a truly Catholic way of life

Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time –
