## Catechism Corner

### RINCÓN CATEQUÉTICO/ Catechetical Corner

#### Understanding the Creed — What Do We Believe? The Creed

is a beautiful and powerful summary of our Catholic faith. It expresses the essential beliefs that unite us as Christians and that the Church has professed, safeguarded, and passed down from the time of the Apostles. When we say, “I believe,” we are not simply stating opinions or preferences—we are declaring our trust in God and our acceptance of the truths He has revealed through Scripture and Sacred Tradition.

- The Creed is structured around the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity: — We believe in God the Father, the Creator of all that exists. — We believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, true God and true man, who became incarnate for our salvation, suffered, died, and rose again. — We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life, who continues to guide and sanctify the Church. The Creed also professes belief in the Church as one, holy, catholic, and apostolic; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and life everlasting.

- By professing the Creed at Mass, we unite ourselves with the universal Church. It is both a declaration of faith and a call to live according to what we believe—faith in action, rooted in truth

Entendiendo el Credo — ¿Qué Creemos? El Credo es un resumen hermoso y profundo de nuestra fe católica. Expresa las creencias esenciales que nos unen como cristianos y que la Iglesia ha proclamado, protegido y transmitido desde el tiempo de los Apóstoles. Cuando decimos “Creo en...”, no estamos compartiendo opiniones, sino declarando nuestra confianza en Dios y aceptando con fe lo que Él nos ha revelado por medio de la Sagrada Escritura y la Tradición.

- El Credo está estructurado en torno al misterio de la Santísima Trinidad: — Creemos en Dios Padre, Creador de todo lo que existe. — Creemos en Jesucristo, su único Hijo, verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre, que se hizo hombre para salvarnos, murió y resucitó. — Creemos en el Espíritu Santo, Señor y dador de vida, que guía y santifica a la Iglesia. También profesamos nuestra fe en la Iglesia que es una, santa, católica y apostólica; en el perdón de los pecados; en la resurrección de los muertos; y en la vida eterna.

- Al rezar el Credo en la Misa, nos unimos a toda la Iglesia. Es una declaración de fe, pero también un llamado a vivir de acuerdo con lo que creemos -- una fe viva y en acción, basada en la verdad.
