# **Catechetical Corner** RINCÓN CATEQUÉTICO

Why Do We Need the Church? Many people today say, "I can believe in God on my own --I don't need the Church." While personal prayer and faith are essential. Christ never intended our relationship with Him to be lived in isolation. He came to form a family, the Church, where we encounter Him fully.

Jesus gave Peter a mission: "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Mt. 16:18). St. Paul reminds us: "You are the body of Christ and individually members of it" (1 Cor. 12:27). Just as no part of the body can survive cut off from the whole, no Christian can flourish apart from the Church.

The Catechism teaches: "The Church is necessary for salvation... Christ is the one mediator and the way of salvation; he is present to us in his body which is the Church" (CCC 846). Through the Church, Christ gives us the sacraments: Baptism makes us God's children, the Eucharist feeds us with His very life, and Reconciliation restores us when we fall.

The saints echo this truth. St. Cyprian boldly declared: "No one can have God as Father who does not have the Church as Mother." St. Augustine compared the Church to Noah's Ark-inside there is salvation; outside, great danger. We need the Church because she gives us what our souls most long for: truth, grace, and community. To belong to the Church is to belong to Christ Himself.
