Please review the following descriptions to help you decide which ministry best fits your time and talents. Lead Catechist– Attend a training session, prepare for each lesson, lead each lesson with the materials provided, adhere to the curriculum and policies of the parish.

Assistant Catechist / Confirmation Small Group Leader – Attend a training session, work with catechists to define tasks in the classroom, support the catechist or Confirmation year group leader in small groups and discussions. May help fill in and lead the group when needed.

Office Assistant – Help prepare materials for the faith formation department. Cut, copy, and do special projects throughout the year.

God Squad – Help welcome youth in grades 1st-5th and adults as they arrive for faith formation sessions on Wednesday nights. Monitor the hallways during faith formation class time.

Joe's Diner – Help prepare and serve a meal to the faith formation families; clean up after the meal is over.
