- 1. **Opening Prayer**: The meeting was opened with prayer. New member Cheri Brausen, Pastoral Care Commission, was welcomed to PPC.
- 2. **Minutes** were approved with following changes: LeAnn Zogg will serve as Recording Scribe. Joshua Bohl was elected as PPC Secretary.
- 3. Preparations for Archdiocesan Synod: 2021 Pentecost Weekend Synod is Scheduled.
  - a. 2-year preparation process where topics for Synod are gathered and developed
  - b. Listening Church Sessions: Fall 2019 March 2020
    - i. Archbishop Hebda will be attending scheduled listening sessions
    - ii. Parish staff and laity input of concerns and future of Archdiocese
    - iii. PPC, staff and church members are invited to attend Listening sessions
  - c. Ambassadors: 12 members from each Parish serve as Ambassadors
    - i. Help develop and guide dialogue with local church/ parishes to gather topics of concern and discussion, help to gather data and information.
    - ii. Training sessions for Ambassadors
    - iii. 2-year commitment
    - iv. Small groups in local church will meet 8 times.
- 4. **Visioning Process for Parish Pastoral Council:** To develop a vision for upgrading/ enhancing/ transforming St Joseph's campus and facilities to meet the future needs of St Joseph Catholic Church.
  - a. Reviewed January brainstorming activities/ listing/ and area assignments
  - b. Visioning Work goal June 2020
  - c. Starred areas: Develop educational wing, staff space, create meeting space, AV Technology, Banquet Space, Special Ministry Space, Expand the Gather space, Plan for growth.
  - d. General Goals: Make a 10-15-year plan that focuses on meeting future needs.
    - i. Create a vision and build how to get there.
    - ii. Commit and empower our parish future and make is happen grow towards what we want St Joseph to become. Vision comes first, then create the steps needed to make it happen. Active role now creates the first steps.
    - iii. Cultivate community growth and active participation.
    - iv. Technology Needs
