“Recognizing racial injustice in our midst allows us to recognize Jesus Christ among us. Christ comes to meet us in those who are broken, in those who are struggling for breath.

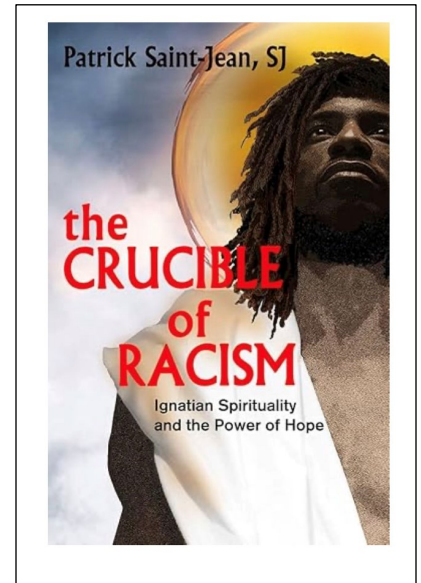
