UPCOMING EVENTS

- February 3 - CONFIRMATION - plan for overflow in lower level but hold them until the Bishop and Conformance have come up from the lower level
- February 14 - ASH WEDNESDAY - Masses at 9am and 6pm
 - Plan for overflow at 6pm Mass with 2 additional ministers for downstairs
 - Extra bowls of ashes to all ministers with script included, need table for ashes bowls
 - All ministers will distribute ashes, sign up on sign up genius
 - Soup supper after 6pm Mass
- LENT
 - Scriptural station of the Cross will be offered on Fridays at 8:30 am prior to the 9:00am Mass. Will be led by one of the following ezzzach Friday: Fran Zuber, Judy Duncan or Paul Bobay.
 - 6pm Mass on Monday and Wednesday throughout Lent except Holy Week.
 - March 25 PALM SUNDAY
 - Palms have been ordered in larger quantity than last year as we ran out and will be distributed at all doors by ministers and ushers
 - Gather outside if weather permits
 - March 26, RECONCILIATION at 7:00 pm.
 - Assisting priests have indicated preference for Chili at their meal before the service so Mike Kelley will prepare it.
- TRIDUUM
 - Sign-up genius to be used for all services
 - Scripts as prior years to be reviewed and revised as needed by Judy Duncan and Father Adam
 - March 29 - HOLY THURSDAY at 6:00 pm
 - presentation of oils has been changed to a different time
 - washing of feet by Parish Council. Pam Bourjaily and Norma Ward will coordinate the four washing stations.
 - Suggest 2 Sacristans, commentator will give plan for procession
 - Fr. Adam to announce time for bring forward of rice bowls.
 - Arts and Environment will process to dress the altar the collection of the rice bowls
 - Altar of Repose in the MPR, Adoration through 11:00 pm (Paul to close), Host to the Sacristy after Adoration

- Parish will process out singing through the north side door and in the front doors, weather permitting. Process internally to the Narthex as an alternative. Quiet is to be maintained after the service has complete.
- March 30 - GOOD FRIDAY to begin at 6:00 pm and proceed as in former years.
- March 31 EASTER VIGIL begin at 8:15 pm
 - Jim Pitcher to light the fire
 - Ushers, ministers and sacristans will be key lighters for the candles. They should be informed prior to the service. There will be no relighting after baptism.
 - Rehearsal required for vigil, revisit this at next meeting

April 1 - EASTER SUNDAY

- Masses at 8:30 am and 11:00 am, expect overflow at both Masses
- sprinkling needs to also be done in the lower level
- Chairs to be set up in lower level, also in MPR with curtains closed on doors until LL filled.
- Need 2 extra ushers for LL, 8 additional ministers for LL and 2 additional for MPR. Will schedule ministers for all Easter Services
- April 7/8 FIRST COMMUNION - at all Masses for a total of 60 children. Will we need extra ministers? Review at next meeting.
