
Brothers and sisters, let us bless the Lord, who went about doing good and healing. Blessed be God now and Forever.

That I am Your beloved one	Jesus, I trust in You

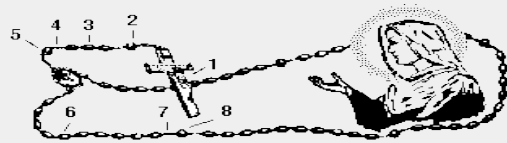
PRAYERS FOR THE FAMILY

ROSARY

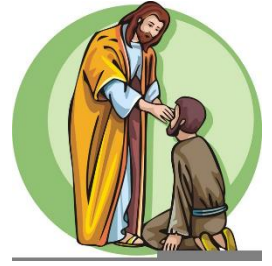
The steps to praying the Rosary are:



1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles' Creed"
2. Say the "Our Father"
3. Say three "Hail Marys" for Faith, Hope, and Charity
4. Say the "Glory Be"
5. Announce the First Mystery and then say the "Our Father"
6. Say ten "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery
7. Say the "Glory Be" (*Optional: Say the "O My Jesus" prayer requested by Mary at Fatima*)
8. Announce the Next Mystery; then say the "Our Father" and repeat these steps (6 through 8) as you continue through the remaining Mysteries.
9. Hail, Holy Queen, Memorare Prayer & Make the "Sign of the Cross"



ROSARY FOR HEALING



1st Luminous Mystery – Christ's Baptism in the Jordan River

In baptism we are invited into God's family. We are to go forth doing the good works of Christ, spreading the goodness of His name, and treating others as we want to be treated. We ask God for the complete healing of _____. 2nd Luminous Mystery – The wedding at Cana

As Christ encountered people in His ministry, He encountered people with needs great and small. Jesus often worked miracles for people who were at their last hope. To receive healing and have miracles happen, we must open ourselves both to the reality that we and all people are loved by God, and to the understanding that it is our faith that will allow miracles to happen. We ask God to restore ____ to abundant living. May Jesus work a miracle in his/her life. Amen.

3rd Luminous Mystery – Jesus' Announcement of the Kingdom of God

Jesus went throughout Galilee healing every disease and sickness among the people. The many who were healed, and the many more who witnessed these miracles, were transformed by their experience of God. We ask God to transform _____ by working a miracle of healing in his/her life. May Jesus, the great Healer, have mercy on _____ and touch him/her, bringing healing to their entire body. Amen.

4th Luminous Mystery – The Transfiguration of Christ

"Jesus took Peter, James, and John up a high mountain by themselves, and Jesus was transfigured before them." God wishes nothing less than our complete healing. To come into the nearness of God is a transforming experience which forever changes us. We have but to reach, and however far we can stretch, it is enough—for Love knows no distance or time. We ask God to reach out his healing hand upon ____ and heal every part of his/her body. May Jesus, the great Healer, have mercy on _____ and help him/her to have total peace. Amen.

5th Luminous Mystery – The institution of the Eucharist

A centurion came to Jesus asking for help. "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed and in terrible suffering." Jesus said to him, "I will go and heal him." The centurion replied "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed." And his servant was healed at that very hour. Lord, we ask that through the power of our faith, you will heal ____ and restore him/her to complete health in mind and body. May Jesus, the great Healer, have mercy on ____, prevent infection & restore his/her body. Bring peace and comfort to their entire family. We ask through the intercession of Mary, our Mother. Amen.

Hail Holy Queen, mother of mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this our exile show us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.
