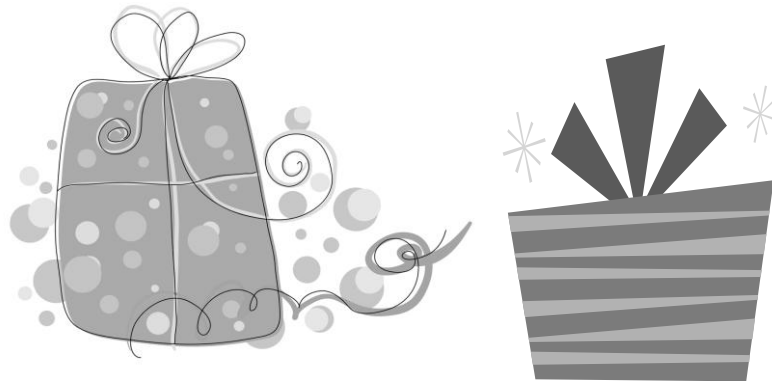


St Rita Stewardship/Gift Assessment Tool 2009
