

Many parishioners were involved by hosting the team of missionary adults in their homes for the week, for an evening dinner with their families, donating and preparing snacks for the children, and more. It was truly a multi-parish endeavor.

Holy Family Catholic School and Preschool – Home of the Eagles

For the 2020-21 school year we didn't know how long we would stay in the building, but in a year of uncertainty and unprecedented times we accomplished A LOT! Our kindergarten and 1st grade classes missed 0 (zero!!) in person days due to COVID-19. 2nd -8th grade were virtual only 7 days at Thanksgiving due to COVID-19 and returned for 2 weeks in the building before Christmas break. Our students missed 0 (zero!!) instructional days in the Spring and Fall of 2020 due to switching to online learning. Our teachers have been (unknowingly) preparing for 2020 for years with monthly educational technology training. They switched from in person to online learning two different times within a weekend! Gries' leadership, our teachers' ability to adapt and their willingness to put students' needs first, our parents trusting in Holy Family and the protocols put in place, and the students coming in excited to learn and be together. Our Ohana relied on each other and stayed strong, making this year truly unforgettable!
