
Pick a way to receive messages for **Parents**:

**A** **If you have a smartphone, get push notifications.**

On your iPhone or Android phone, open your web browser and go to the following link:

Follow the instructions to sign up for Remind. You'll be prompted to download the mobile app.



**B** **If you don't have a smartphone, get text notifications.**

Text the message [@spcs1881](https://www.remind.com/@spcs1881) to the number **81010**.

If you're having trouble with **81010**, try texting [@spcs1881](https://www.remind.com/@spcs1881) to **(262)581-4308**.

## **St. Peter Catholic School Remind (SPCSSlinger) Frequently Asked Questions**

**What is Remind?** Remind is a website that provides a safe way for schools to text message or email students and parents. For the purpose of our school, we will ONLY be communicating to parents.

**How does Remind work?** First, our school secretary made a class (or group) called “parents” which generated a unique code. We then share that code with parents. At that point, any parent who sends a text message with the code will be "subscribed" to the “parents” class. Any time our school secretary sends a message from Remind, all the parents subscribed will receive it. Using this method, no one knows each other's cell phone number; the school secretary only sees a name in his/her sign-up list online, not even the phone numbers.

**Is Remind free?** The service is free, but standard messaging rates apply. So, if you do not have unlimited texting on your cell phone's data plan, you might be charged for each text message.

**How will St. Peter Catholic School be using Remind?** Parents today are very busy and they communicate primarily by texting. St. Peter Catholic School’s purpose with Remind is to provide parents with timely reminders or news of weather emergencies or bus delays. These messages travel one-way only, from the school to parents; you cannot respond to texts and there will not be an on-going conversation of any kind. It is very safe and hopefully, very effective.

**How does a student or parent sign up for St. Peter Catholic School’s messages?** As a parent, you never need to come to a website or create an account. To sign up for our school’s messages, you need our school’s “Parents” class code and class phone number. You then have the option to receive his/her messages via text, email or both.

*To receive text messages:* Text @spcs1881 to the 81010. If you’re having trouble with 81010, try texting @spcs1881 to (262) 581-4308. For example, you would send the text message: @spcs1881 ---- to --- 81010

*To receive messages via email:* Go to [rmd.at/spcs1881](http://rmd.at/spcs1881) on a desktop computer to sign up for email notifications.

**How do students or parents opt out of receiving message?** Text message: To unsubscribe from all classes, simply reply with the word "unsubscribe." Email: Reply to our school’s email via Remind with the word "unsubscribe" in the subject field to stop receiving notifications for that class.

**Do I have to have a SmartPhone for Remind?** No, any phone that receives text messages will work with Remind 101. There is also a Remind App that is free.
