Your Holiness,

Thank you for taking the time to read my letter to you. My name is Fr. Mario Orrigo. I am the Pastor of Saint Patrick Parish, Stoneham, Massachusetts USA. I have been a priest in the Archdiocese of Boston for twenty-two years. I write to you with all due respect about the current climate and situation in our Church concerning sexual abuse. We are under assault from the devil himself, and we need the Blessed Mother's help. Your Holiness, we don't need any more commissions, groups, hired firms or high priced consultative companies to help us walk through this quagmire, what we do need is to humble ourselves and return to our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.
