In-Person Class Parent Instructions

Grades 1-7

The most important way to build your child's faith is to attend Mass, either in-person or online, pray together at night, before meals, and as a family.

At these meetings, the catechist and a staff member will work with the students to review the most important points of the 2-3 chapters/sessions the students were asked to read before class. Please ensure your child reads the chapters/sessions before the class meeting in order to get the most out of his or her class experience.

All students will be expected to behave according to standard school expectations. We also ask all students to be respectful of the spaces we use, especially the school classrooms. Please review common behavioral expectations with your child.

If your child will miss a class, please email us and use the *Missed Class Parent Instructions* to make up the material missed at the class.
