St. John the Baptist

St. John the Baptist was born in the year 5 B.C. He was six months old when Jesus was born.

When John was older he moved into the wilderness. He started his public ministry around 30 A.D. John attracted large crowds for baptizing.

When Jesus came to be baptized, John saw him and said "It is I who needs baptism from you." Jesus told John to baptize him anyway. So he did. The Holy Spirit came down in the form of a dove and a booming voice called out saying "This is my beloved son in whom I am well pleased." The dove disappeared and the day became beautiful.

John died around 33 and 36 A.D. His feast day is on June 24.

St. John the Baptist showed faith, by trusting in God to watch over him during his time in the wild.






Max received 2nd place for the 10 years old and under category.
