PROCEDURE FOR SERVING STATIONS OF THE CROSS

February 16-March 30, 2018

(Approximately ½ hour)

1. Plan to arrive no later than 8:30 for the Stations. (Stations will begin shortly after the 8AM Mass is over.) The only preparation for this assignment is to put on your alb. While the 8AM Mass Altar Server is in the sanctuary collecting the vessels—if this hasn't already been done—place two boxes of the red, *The Way of the Cross* booklets on the ledge at the back of the church. It may be helpful to pass out the booklets to those who remain after the Mass. Following the Stations, help the Sacristan collect the booklets, box them, and return them to the counter in the sacristy.
2. The Stations of the Cross begin and end in silence. You will carry the processional cross throughout the devotion. When the priest or deacon is ready, lead him down the center aisle to the foot of the altar, turn and take a few steps to the left. After the Opening Prayer, which the priest or deacon reads at the foot of the altar, he will turn toward you. Lead him to the First Station by way of the outside aisle. Stand slightly to the left of center at each Station allowing him space to center himself in front of the Station. You will stand facing the same direction—either the Stations or the assembly—as the clergy you are serving.
3. Even if the priest or deacon kneels at each Station, you are to remain standing. While he is reading, bow your head, allowing your forehead to rest on the post of the processional cross. When he turns toward you, lead him to the next Station.
4. After he has completed the Fourteenth Station, lead him back to the foot of the altar and stand behind him just as you would for any recessional procession. Following the recitation of *The Apostles' Creed* by the assembly, the priest or deacon will turn toward you. Lead him back up the center aisle to the sacristy.
