Feast of Christ the King

This weekend in the Church, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King, King of the Universe. Hence, I think that it is important that we take a look at the history of how this celebration came about.

The earliest Christians identified Jesus with the predicted Messiah of the Jews. The Jewish word "Messiah," and the Greek word "Christ," both mean "anointed one," and came to refer to the expected king who would deliver Israel from the hands of the Romans. Christians believe that Jesus is this expected Messiah. Unlike the messiah most Jews expected, Jesus came to free all people, Jew and Gentile, and he did not come to free them from the Romans, but from sin and death. Thus the King of the Jews, and of the cosmos, does not rule over a kingdom of this world.

Christians have long celebrated Jesus as Christ, and his reign as King is celebrated to some degree in [Advent](#) (when Christians wait for his second coming in glory), [Christmas](#) (when "born this day is the King of the Jews"), [Holy Week](#) (when Christ is the Crucified King), [Easter](#) (when Jesus is resurrected in power and glory), and the [Ascension](#) (when Jesus returns to the glory he had with the Father before the world was created). However, Pius XI wanted to specifically commemorate Christ as king, and instituted the feast in the Western calendar in 1925.

In the 21st century many Western Christians, Catholic and Protestant, celebrate Christ the King Sunday, including Anglicans and Lutherans. Unfortunately, in some mainline Protestant churches, "king" language is not popular, and the feast is downplayed. However, in a chaotic and unjust world that seems to scorn any kind of authority, many Christians proudly celebrate Christ the King Sunday, where the loving and merciful - and just - king of the universe is praised and glorified.

Let us embrace the opportunity to accept Jesus as Lord and King of our lives, and ask for many blessings to prepare ourselves to be heirs of the kingdom that will have no end.

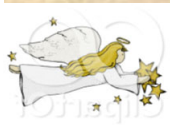

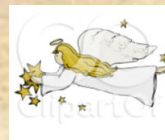

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Jubilee Year Ends

Today Luke, evangelist and by tradition artist, sends us forth from this Jubilee Year of Mercy with an unforgettable portrait of Christ the King. The setting for Jesus' "royal portrait" is the cross. From this "throne," the crucified "crown prince" welcomes by "executive pardon" the kingdom of mercy's first citizen, a fellow criminal. The "Good Thief" requests neither deliverance nor salvation, or even forgiveness: "Remember me when . . ." (Luke 23:42). "Today you will be with me," King Jesus promises, "in paradise." (23:43). Paradise, even for non-believers, is an image of creation contentedly in harmony with self, fellow creatures, and Creator. Today, we "good thieves" beg Jesus to remember us. We promise to remember that, although Jesus' kingdom will be fulfilled only when Jesus' returns, that kingdom begins today in the paradise that will flower from this Jubilee Year of Mercy. We disciples, having been embraced unconditionally and undeservedly by Jesus' mercy, must now go forth to embrace all others, unconditionally, with that same unfailing mercy.

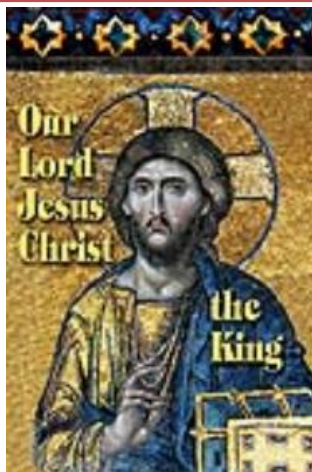

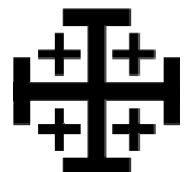
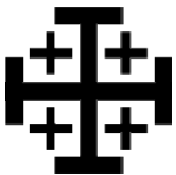
Los cristianos de los primeros días identificaron a Jesús como el Mesías que predecían los judíos. La palabra judía “Mesías” y la palabra griega “Cristo”, ambas significan “El ungido” y terminaron refiriéndose al Rey que se esperaba que salvaría a Israel de las manos de los romanos. Los cristianos creen que Jesús es el Mesías que esperaban. Contrariamente al Mesías que los Judíos esperaban, Jesús vino a liberar a toda la gente, Judíos y gentiles por igual, y Él no vino a liberarlos de los romanos pero del pecado y la muerte. De ese modo el Rey de los judíos, y del Cosmos entero, no gobierna sobre un reino sino sobre todo el mundo.

Los Cristianos han celebrado a Jesús como el Cristo y su reinado como Rey es celebrado de un modo u otro en [Adviento](#) (cuando los cristianos esperan por su segunda venida en Gloria), [Navidad](#) (cuando “nació en ese día el Rey de los Judíos”), [Semana Santa](#) (cuando Cristo es crucificado Rey), [Pascua](#) (cuando Jesús es resucitado en Poder y Gloria), y en la [Asunción](#) (cuando Jesús regresa a la Gloria que Él tenía con el Padre antes de que el mundo fuera creado). Aun así, el Papa Pio XI quiso conmemorar específicamente a Cristo como Rey, e instituyó la fiesta en el calendario occidental en 1925.

Muchos cristianos occidentales en el siglo 21, (católicos y protestantes) celebran el domingo de Cristo Rey, incluyendo anglicanos y luteranos. Desafortunadamente, en algunas Iglesias protestantes tradicionales, la palabra “Rey” no es muy popular, y el festejo es minimizado. Sin embargo, en un mundo injusto y caótico que parece desdeñar cualquier tipo de autoridad, muchos cristianos orgullosamente celebramos el domingo de Cristo Rey, donde el amoroso y misericordioso – y justo – Rey del Universo es alabado y glorificado.

Adoptemos la oportunidad de aceptar a Jesús como el Señor y Rey de nuestras vidas, y pidamos todas las bendiciones que necesitemos para prepararnos a ser herederos del reino que no tiene fin.

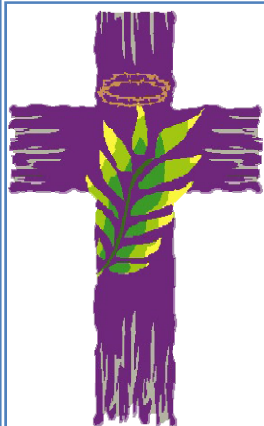

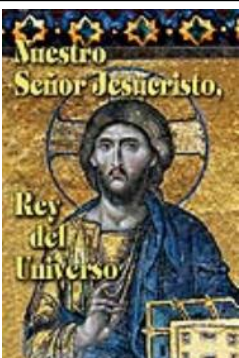

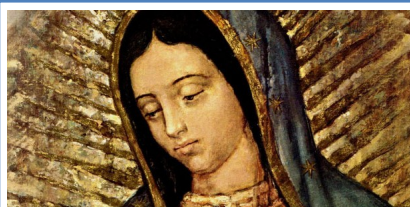
